

Jackson County Non-Partisan County Commissioner Petition Instruction Sheet

- 1) Anyone registered to vote in Jackson County is eligible to sign the petition.
- 2) Signatures must be witnessed by the circulator; do NOT leave petitions unattended and do NOT accept signatures not witnessed by the circulator.
- 3) Try to get as many signatures per sheet as you can! However, it is not required that a sheet have all 10 signatures. Turn in what you have. Every signature counts.
- 4) Note that the petitions are double sided; one side has information and instructions, the other side records the signatures. **Petitions MUST be printed double sided.** Any signatures are null and void if they're not recorded on double sided petitions. *Do not make physical copies from an already printed sheet, only print from the PDF on the website.* NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- 5) Go to **www.votingforthepeople.com** for more blank petitions, fact sheets, the latest progress updates, and to donate. If you prefer, **signature pages can be mailed to you**, just contact Kevin Stine via the information below.
- 6) Ensure that once the sheet is completed that the four items are filled out on the Circulator Certification section of the signature sheet. Signature, date, print name, and address. Sheet number is filled out later by the petition committee.
- 7) Make sure the date you put on the bottom of the signature page, in the Circulator Certification section, is later than or equal to the latest date of any signatory.
- 8) You can mail your sheets to Kevin Stine's address below, or drop them off to the Jackson County Democrats office at 110 E. 6th St, Medford, OR 97501. The office is open Tuesday – Thursday 11AM – 2PM. You can also pick up more blank petition sheets at the Democratic Party office.
